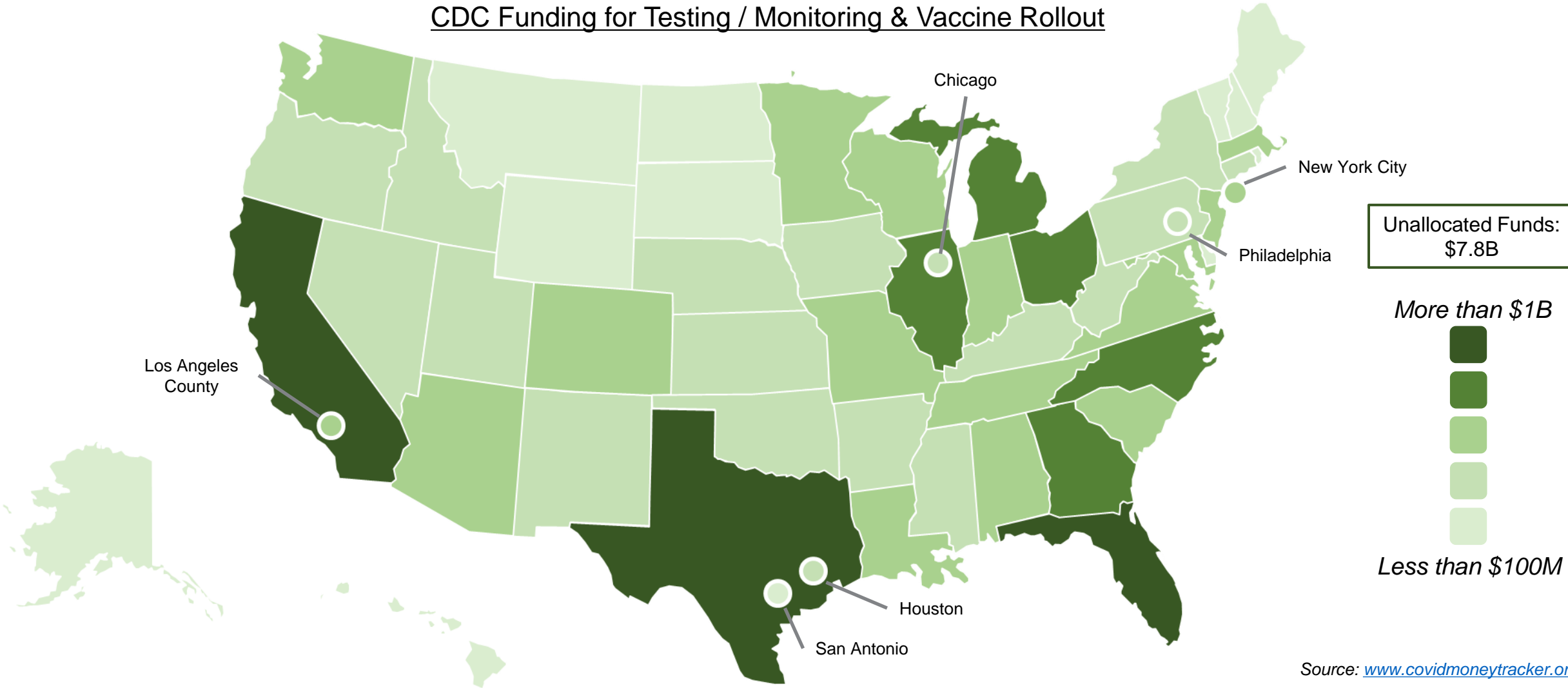

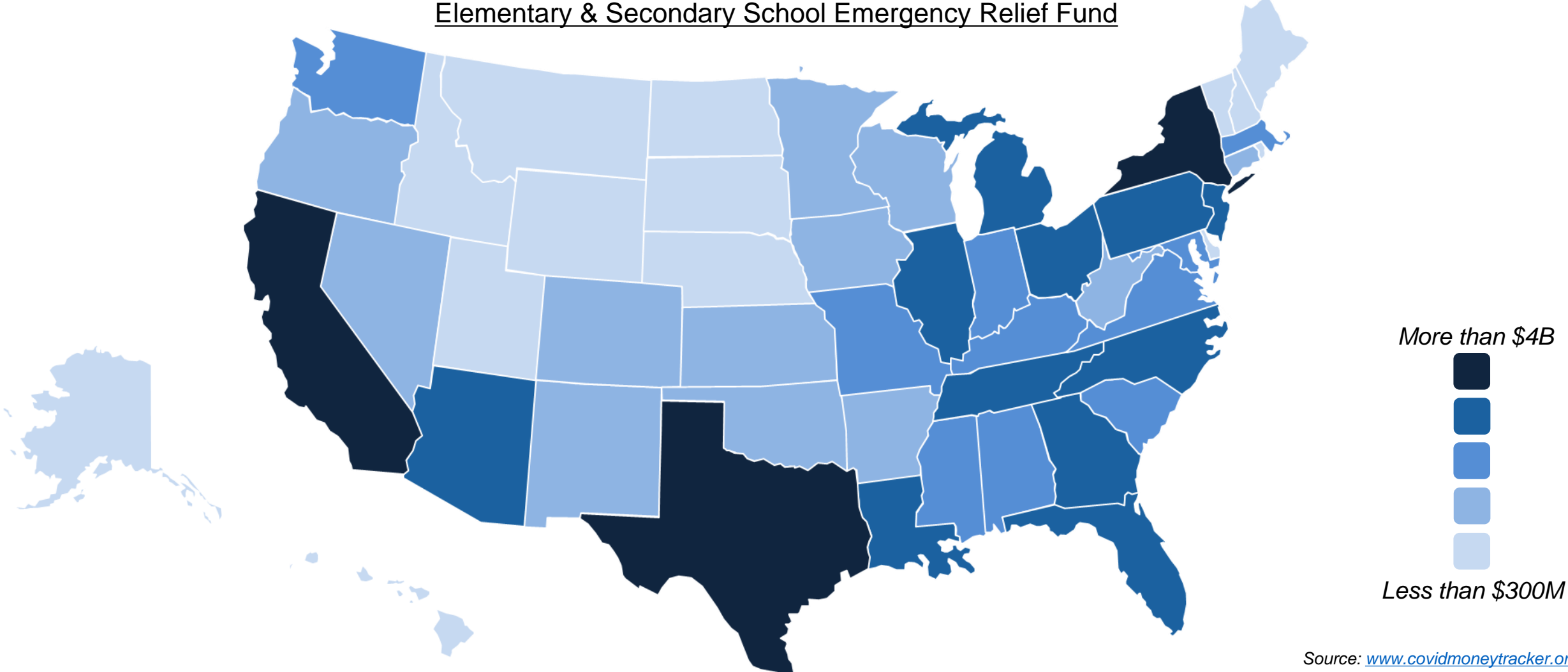
K-12 Schools

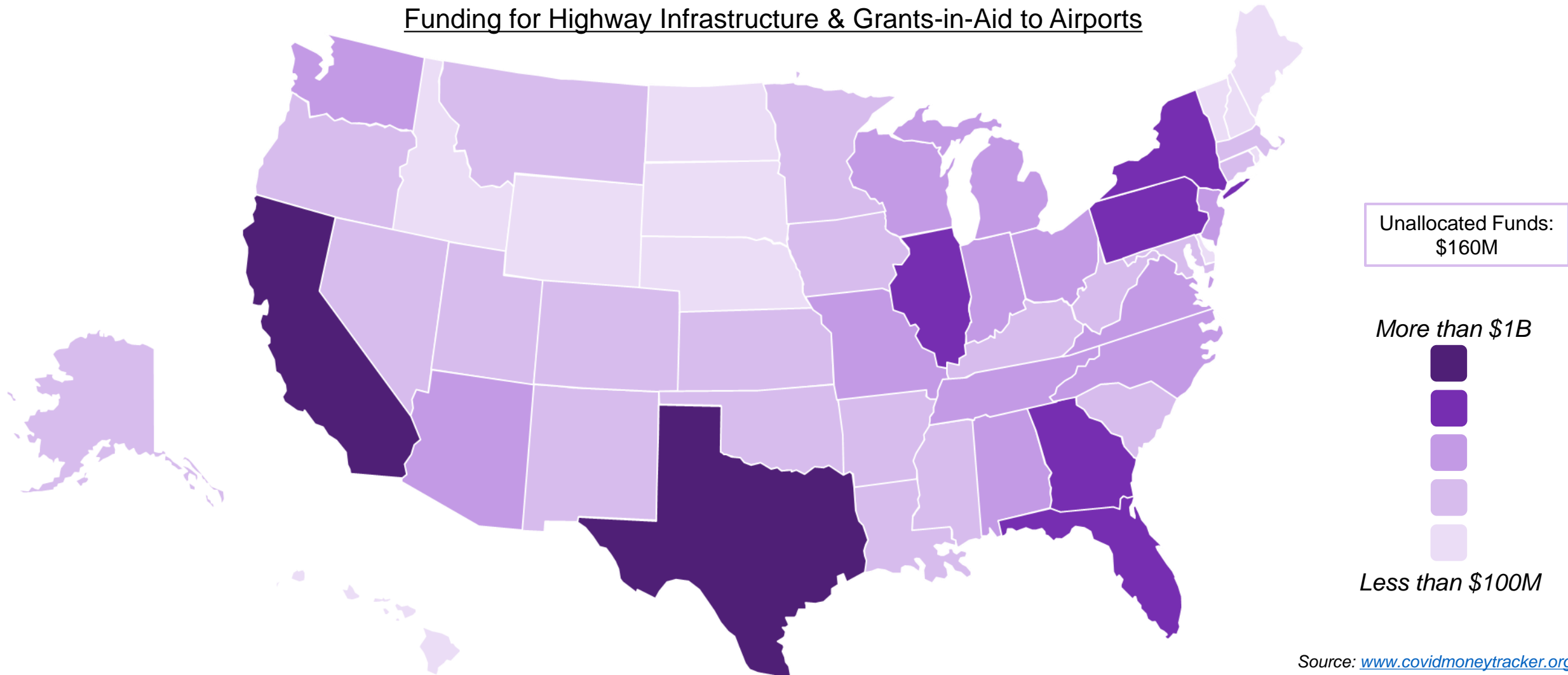
